- The Jags high octane passing attack led by Nick Mullens put up over 250 yards and 2 TD's in the first half. MJ Brown led the Jags in receiving with 56 yards in only a half of work.
- Senior kicker Hudson Carr booted a 45 yard field goal to give the Jags confidence going into the season.
- The offensive line were missing 3 starters in the pre-season scrimmage nursing injuries, but look for the men up front to be ready to go in the season opener.
- The Jaguars enters its second year in the Lindsey up tempo offense. With a better understanding and an experienced senior QB, this squad is looking to break out.

SPAIN PARK DEFENSIVE NOTES



- The defensive unit had a great warm up holding the Homewood offense to only 120 total yards, and creating 2 turnovers.
- UAB commit Je'Niah Jackson led the team with 8 tackles
- Things get tougher in river city for the defense with most of the Black Bear offense unit returning. In 2011, Austin averaged 31.1 points per game
